



FROM PARISH NURSE DIANA SAUM, RN: Excessive heat can cause problems for all of us, but especially those over 65 years of age. Our bodies lose the ability to ish Nurse deal with heat as we age. In extreme heat, blood is redirected

to the skin to help cool us. To compensate, the body makes more blood so that the organs will get enough, but that takes a lot of water, adding to the chance of becoming dehydrated. The sense of thirst diminishes with age plus older kidneys aren't as good at keeping fluids in the system. Medications can also impact sweating. If you exercise on a hot day, you can become so dehydrated that you end up with too little blood flow to organs such as the brain and heart. (To be continued in September, Messenger)
