shut-ins who should be included to Cynthia Yoder or Opal Wolff. Volunteers to help make deliveries are needed.





FROM PARISH NURSE, DIANA SAUM, RN: STROKE - If you suspect a stroke use the acronym "F.A.S.T"

- F Face; has their face fallen on one side? Can they smile?
- A Arms; can they raise both arms and hold them up?
- S Speech; is their speech slurred? Can they speak?
- T Time; speedy treatment saves brain cells.

Call 911, get to the hospital.

If you suddenly develop two or more of these symptoms, get medical help for evaluation: Vision changes, dizziness, nausea, headache, disorientation, vomiting, sudden hiccups. Say to 911 or hospital: "I think I am having a stroke, I have never had these symptoms before." Time is of the essence.
