
Thanks to your faithful giving and some special deposits, we have come through the summer with a positive balance. We did fall into a negative balance at times, but overall, we are still in

- 1 Comb Sturdy, longer than at least 6"; <u>No</u> rattail or picks, please
- 1 Toenail or fingernail clipper <u>No</u> emery boards or metal nail files, please
- 1 Bath-size soap 3 oz. bar or larger in original packaging <u>No</u> lvory or Jergen's
- 1 Adult toothbrush in its original packaging10 Adhesive bandages 3/4"x3" (Band-aids or similar)
- 1 One-gallon size re-sealable plastic bag
  - All items must be new
  - Do not wash any of the items as they will no longer be considered new
  - Contents of kits or the containers of kits should not be imprinted with cartoon characters, advertisements, religious, patriotic, military or camouflage symbols
